This month in AA History:

- 1938 Bill W starts writing the Big Book of Alcoholics Anonymous
- 1941 The Saturday Evening Post article hit the stands and created a national sensation. AA membership quadrupled in one year from 2000 to 4000
- 1941 Boston newspaper reported that any drunk who wanted to get well was more than welcome at the AA meeting being held Wednesday evenings
- 1941 Sober date of Sybil C first woman to join AA west of the Mississippi
- 1941 First AA Prison group started at San Quentin
- 1944 New York intergroup was established
- 1946 The Jefferson Barracks in Missouri formed what is believed to be the first AA group in a military installation
- 1947 Nell Wing, Bill's secretary and first archivist of AA began her career at Alcoholics Anonymous
- 1947 First AA group was formed in London, England
- 1951 Dr. William Duncan Silkworth died at Towns Hospital
- 1951 American Weekly publishes memorial article for Dr. Bob
- 1966 Ebby Thatcher, Bill Wilson's sponsor, died sober
