## ZOOM updates coming our way - September, 2020

ZOOM had planned to initiate either passcode or waiting room requirements for all paid accounts on JULY 19 ${ }^{\text {th }}$. However, due to feedback from consumers, the new requirements will begin September 27, 2020. If your meetings already use a passcode (formerly known as password) or a waiting room feature, your meetings will not be affected. However, if you have not enabled the passcode feature by September $27^{\text {th }}$, your meetings will automatically default to use of a waiting room.
